

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT:

As a parent, we are sure that you have many questions now that your child is in our care. You may be feeling uncertain or uneasy about your child entering into residential placement, but rest assured, we will guide you and your child through his or her treatment process. We believe that family involvement is an integral part of our treatment process. It is our goal to provide both you and your child with a positive Abraxas experience. Your child will call home upon arrival to the program or within 24 hours of his or her admission.

The program will contact you within 72 hours of your child's admission to inform you who your child's counselor is and to answer any questions you may have.

You will receive a Family Packet via mail specific to your child's program within one week of your child's admission. *(*At some locations parents are required to be present for their child's admission into treatment and are provided with a Family Packet at that time.)*

Please work with your child's counselor to arrange visitation, as visitation days and hours vary by program. We do provide transportation for parents at certain locations. Please speak with your child's counselor for details.

Family counseling is provided at most locations.

Video conferencing is available at some locations.
